




Global passenger kilometres flown (RPKs), indexed




Aug. 2021 Domestic Passenger Demand*

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*measured in RPKs (Revenue Passenger Kilometers)












Pent-up demand: surge in bookings upon US announcement



Bookings US-Europe, 7-day MA in % change vs 2019 Source: IATA Economics using data from DDS


... But Q4 bookings still well below pre-crisis levels



Global cumulative passenger bookings for Q4 travel Source: IATA Economics using data from DDS ticketing database




Quickest recovery: short-haul and leisure travel market






